


West Michigan Health Careers Council is a collaborative of health systems, educators, workforce development, and economic development organizations.

Key Accomplishments

Three sessions of Implicit Bias Training

- Free to health care workers throughout west Michigan, funded by West Michigan Health Careers Council
- Over 50 individuals registered
- 27 different health care organizations

Community Health Worker Training

- WMHCC funded 13 individuals to attend a three-month training through GRCC and Spectrum Health
- 7 individual job seekers, WIOA qualified
- 6 individuals already employed within the industry

Apprenticeship Development

- 5 established programs, 2 more in the process
- 161 graduated apprentices since 2016
- Leveraged funding from 6 sources to provide \$80,000+ in tuition assistance.

- Strategic planning to address new health care pain points in a changing landscape.
- Comprehensive credential directory of health care training programs in the region.
- Continue to develop new and existing apprenticeship programs.
